

## **RECYCLING INFORMATION**

**The City of Salem is under contract with the Sioux Falls Regional Landfill for their disposal of solid waste and recycling materials**

Recycling is **MANDATED** in Salem.

The landfill has set specific guidelines and goals for the haulers regardless if they are hauling for **RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS**, so please do your part and recycle.

Residential customers are provided a Recycling Cart, and Commercial customers should contact their hauler to establish procedures and guidelines to meet the needs of their business. If you are an apartment, mobile home park owner or have rental property, please provide your tenants the required information for recycling in your establishment.

**The following items are NOT allowed in the landfills and MUST BE RECYCLED**

Corrugated Cardboard, Newspaper (including ads), Magazines, Junk Mail/Office paper, Chipboard (cereal boxes), Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs, and containers (NO larger than a 5-gallon bucket. NO metal parts or handles.), Aluminum beverage cans, Tin/Steel Cans (aerosol cans are ok if contents are completely exhausted), Clean aluminum foil and trays, Glass bottles & jars.

Single Stream Recycling – all recyclables, including glass, can be combined in one container.

***STICKERS FOR EXTRA GARBAGE, APPLIANCES, MATTRESS, BOX SPRING, & ADDITIONAL ITEMS CAN BE PURCHASED AT CITY HALL FOR VARIOUS FEES***

## **PAYMENT OPTIONS**

**In Person:** Customers may pay bills at Salem City Hall, 400 N. Main Street, during regular business hours. There is a secure drop box in the entryway available during or after business hours.

**By Mail:** City of Salem, PO Box 249, Salem, SD, 57058.

**Automated Bill Payment Plan:** (ACH) Monthly payments can be deducted from the customer's checking or savings account for payment of your water works bill. If interested in signing up for direct deposit, please contact City Hall or download the authorization form from Salem's website – [www.salemsd.com](http://www.salemsd.com).

**Credit/Debit Card & E-Check:** The City of Salem offers the option of paying your Salem Water Works Bill by debit/credit card or e-check through the GovPayNet.com website. A Convenience Fee of 2.65% is assessed to each transaction. There is a minimum Convenience Fee of \$1.00 for all transactions \$37.55 or under. This option is available on the City's Website using the "On-Line Payments" button under the "City Government" tab at the top of the page or at City Hall. Fees are set by GovPayNet.com and subject to change.

<b>ST</b> – STORM/SEWER FEE Flat Fee -----	\$ 5.00
<b>S1</b> – SEWER SURCHARGE (Debt Retirement) -----	\$17.75
<b>SE</b> – SEWER FEE Residential – Flat Fee -----	\$22.25
Commercial 40% of Water Rate but not less than \$22.25	
<b>GA</b> – GARBAGE Residential (includes tax) -----	\$16.94

### **OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS:**

<b>WA</b> – WATER RATE .0045 Cents/Gal + Flat Fee -----	\$29.38
<b>W1</b> – WATER SURCHARGE (Debt Retirement) -----	\$ 9.90
<b>W2</b> – WATER SURCHARGE (Debt Retirement) -----	\$2.00
<b>SE</b> – SEWER RATE Residential – Flat Fee -----	\$24.25
<b>S1</b> – SEWER SURCHARGE (Debt Retirement) -----	\$17.75
<b>GA</b> – GARBAGE Residential (includes tax) -----	\$16.94

***Senior Citizen living alone on Social Security will receive a \$3.00 Water and \$1.00 Garbage discount with a signed affidavit, please call or stop by City Hall with questions or to sign up for this discount.***

### **SERVICE APPLICATION**

An application for service must be filled out and filed with City Hall. All water users shall make a deposit as established by Resolution of the Salem City Council before water services will be connected.

Deposits will be held in trust until service has been discontinued at which time deposits will be refunded or used to pay the final water bill. User will forfeit deposit if written notification of service termination is not provided.

Fees are set by Resolution of the City Council and subject to change

## **RULES**

- 1.) Bill must be paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month.
- 2.) If payment or notification is NOT made to the City by the 10<sup>th</sup>, a \$5.00 delinquent charge will be assessed and disconnect notices will be issued.
- 3.) If water service is discontinued due to a delinquent bill, a \$150.00 fee plus the amount due must be paid before water service will be resumed.
- 4.) If an NSF check is received, there will be \$40.00 charge added to the amount owed.
- 5.) Flat Fee rate for water and all debt retirement surcharges will be assessed during any voluntary or delinquent bill water shut-off.
