

FACILITY RULES

- All swimmers **MUST** take a shower before entering the pool.
- Swimming suits of acceptable hygienic standards and style **MUST** be worn. Jean cut-offs may ONLY be worn if hemmed.
- Anyone who has open sores, cuts, ear, eye, or nose infections **WILL NOT** be allowed in the pool area. Band-Aids are not allowed in pool.
- Unauthorized use of the pool is prohibited.
- This is a **TOBACCO FREE, DRUG FREE, and ALCOHOL FREE** facility. Any of these acts will be cause for expulsion of a patron and/or termination of an employee.
- Profanity, improper behavior or vulgar language WILL NOT be tolerated.
- **NO PETS** are allowed in the pool area or building.
- **NO FOOD OR DRINKS** are allowed in the pool area.
- **NO DIAPERS** are allowed in the pool. Kids (not potty trained) must wear “Little Swimmers” or disposable swim pants.
- **NO RUNNING, DUNKING, or HORSEPLAY** is allowed.
- Only one person allowed on the diving boards/ladders at a time.
- No repeated bouncing on the diving board or diving off the sides of the boards.
- **NO HANGING** on the diving board & rope(s) is allowed.
- **NO DIVING** in marked areas.
- Swimming under the diving boards or diving area is **PROHIBITED**.
- Diving board use - **NO** catching from the water or assisting from the sidelines or deck of the pool. This is for liability and safety reasons.
- All children under the age of 6 **MUST** be supervised by a person 12 years or older. The supervisor must be present and watching the child at all times – this includes both the pool and wader.
- Jumping or diving from the boards and/or is 2nd pool is restricted to qualified swimmers who have successfully swum one lap of the pool (no dog paddling). Lifeguards **MUST** observe this test and their decision stands.
- Only lifeguards are allowed in or on guard chairs.
- No visiting with lifeguards while they are on duty.
- Swimming pool personnel **ARE NOT** responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Except for emergencies, **NO ONE** other than Pool & City employees are allowed in the concession room, pump room & storage shed at any time.
- Persons expelled from the pool **WILL NOT** be let back in until a parent **AND** a member of the Pool Committee has signed their expulsion slip. A person expelled for the third time will be expelled for the remainder of the summer.
- The lifeguards will be on a one-half hour rotation and no breaks will be taken during the afternoon and evening sessions; unless, 1) extreme heat and/or high humidity conditions exist and for the safety of the guards and pool patrons a break is necessary.

The pool rules and regulations are made and enforced for your safety. Please be considerate of other swimmers and the responsibilities of the pool staff.
