**Trees & Untreated Wood:** Scrap lumber, trees, tree branches & brush


## Salem Animal Regulations

A reminder to all pet owners in Salem:

- Households are limited to (3) domestic pets over the age of six months.
- An annual license fee of \$10.00 for each animal must be purchased at the Finance Office.
- Animals are not permitted to run at large - \$50 First Offense, \$100 each additional time, \$50 impounding or boarding fee
- Owners shall not permit dog(s) to disturb the peace and quiet of the neighborhood.
- It is the duty of the owner to clean up and dispose of any animal feces produced by the animal.

## Snow Removal & Parking Regulations

**Duty to Remove.** It shall be the duty of the owner, tenant, or person in possession of any property abutting any sidewalk to keep such sidewalk free from snow and to cause any accumulated snow to be removed within forty-eight (48) hours after the termination of any snowfall, or snow accumulation. Those depositing snow from their driveways or sidewalks onto either City Property or property not their own are doing so illegally; unless prior approval from property owner or City Council was received.

**Prohibited Parking After Snowfall.** In the event of two (2) or more inches of snow thus creating the necessity to blade and/or remove snow from City streets, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle or allow a vehicle to remain parked on any public street within the City beyond six (6) hours following the initial two (2) inch accumulation of snow. Authorized law enforcement may ticket (\$25) and authorize towing of vehicles in violation



## When are Building Permits Required

In addition to new construction; storage sheds, fences, additions, siding, window replacement, decks and any major remodeling projects inside or outside your home require a building permit. There are some exceptions (i.e. shingling does not require a building permit, unless, upgrading from asphalt to shake or steel roofing), so please contact City Hall before starting any remodeling or building projects.

## **RECYCLING INFORMATION**

The City of Salem is under contract with the Sioux Falls Regional Landfill for their disposal of solid waste and recycling materials. Recycling is **MANDATED** in Salem as we not only are required by contract, but it is good for the environment. The landfill has set specific guidelines and goals for the haulers regardless if they are hauling for **RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS**, so please do your part to recycle.



Residential customers are provided a Recycling Cart and are offered the Recycle Bank program as part of their monthly garbage fee. The rules and guidelines are in the paperwork distributed annually.

The Commercial customers in Salem are also mandated to recycle and should contact their hauler to establish procedures and guidelines to meet the needs of their particular business. If you are an apartment, mobile home park owner or have rental property, please provide your tenants the required information for recycling in your establishment.

### **What to Recycle?**

Single Stream Recycling – all recyclables, including glass, can be combined in one container.

### **The following items are NOT allowed in the landfills and MUST BE RECYCLED:**

- Corrugated Cardboard
- Newspaper (including ads)
- Magazines
- Junk Mail/Office paper
- Chipboard (cereal boxes)
- Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs, and containers (NO larger than a 5 gallon bucket. NO metal parts or handles.)
- Aluminum beverage cans
- Tin/Steel Cans (aerosol cans are ok if contents are completely exhausted)
- Clean aluminum foil and trays
- Plastic grocery bags and trash bags
- Glass BOTTLES AND JARS\*
- Electronics
- Appliances

\* Glass is not banned but can be recycled.

### **Items NOT acceptable for recycling:**

- Tyvek or nylon envelopes
- Styrofoam
- Wax paper
- Paper plates
- Photographs
- Plastic silverware
- Tissue paper or paper towels
- Straws
- Foil lined paper
- Diapers
- Bright neon colored or heavily colored paper
- Flexible packaging
- Gift wrap
- Cereal bags
- Appliances
- Window glass
- De-humidifiers
- Mirror glass
- Air conditioners
- Shower curtains
- Any trash
- Cups and lids
- Hazardous materials
- Piping
- Food bags (ex: potato chip bags, frozen foods)
- Wax milk cartons
- Aseptic containers (ex: juice boxes)
