

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE SALEM CITY COUNCIL HELD IN THE MCCOOK CENTRAL SCHOOL DDN ROOM IN SALEM SOUTH DAKOTA ON TUESDAY, JULY 9, 2024, AT 5:00 P.M.

Mayor Glenda Blindert called the public hearing to order with Council Members Ron Mayrose, Mitch Rayman, Janet Karel and Dnyee Schierholz present. Jacob Morris and Trent Bruce of DGR; Kent Osborne, Alex Osborne and R.H. Nolte were also present. Council members Doug Mokros and Marc Harris were absent. Motions made were unanimous of Council members present unless roll call identifies otherwise.

A public hearing is being held for the Proposed Resolution of Necessity at which time the City Council shall consider any objections to the proposed resolution by owners of property liable to be assessed for the improvement.

City Engineers Morris and Bruce explained the project scope as repairs and/or additions of curb and gutter, driveway approaches and asphalt. Assessments are only for where this infrastructure does not exist. Project area maps for 2022, 2023 and 2024 were shown. These improvements are being made to help with drainage and save existing streets.

Mayor Blindert opened the floor for comments.

Alex Osborn asked if any additional storm sewer is being added.

Morris stated this is not a complete rebuild of a street so no new storm sewer will be added.

No further comments.

Motion Rayman, second Karel, carried, to adjourn at 5:12 PM.
