RESOLUTION OF COMMITMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Salem is desirous of requesting assistance from the South Dakota Department of Transportation Community Access Program for the purpose of completing a proposed street reconstruction and improvement project along Hollister Avenue between Nebraska and Douglas; and Douglas between Rutan and 200' North of Center Ave. Proposed improvements are intended to include upgrades to existing underground utilities, storm sewer, and street surfacing, and

WHEREAS, the Salem City Council does hereby commit to the continued maintenance of the project and,

WHEREAS, the Salem City Council makes a firm financial commitment to cover the costs of the engineering and the local match for the project and,

WHEREAS, the Salem City Council acknowledges its responsibility to secure any needed right-of-way or easements for construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salem City Council does hereby adopt this resolution authorizing the filing of the grant application, including all understandings and assurances contained therein, for the South Dakota Department of Transportation Community Access Program, and does hereby authorize the Mayor to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.
